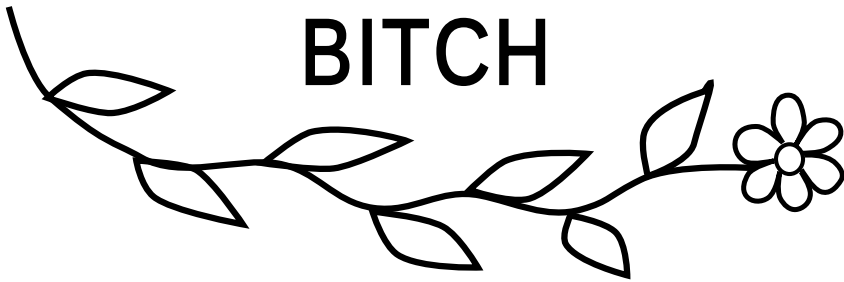

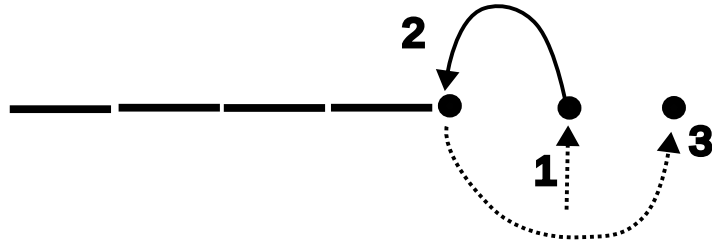


# Stitch Guide

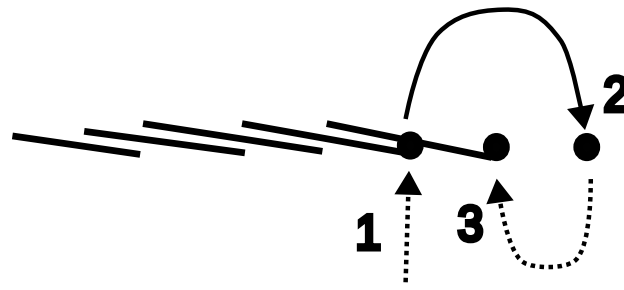
- 1: "IF I'VE EVER" = 3 Strand Backstitch
- 2: "OFFENDED YOU" = 3 Strand Backstitch
- 3: "I'M SORRY" = 3 Strand Backstitch
- 4: "THAT YOU'RE" = 3 Strand Backstitch
- 5: "A LITTLE" = 3 Strand Backstitch
- 6: "BITCH" = 3 Strand Backstitch
- 7: Vines = 3 Strand Stem Stitch
- 8: Leaves = 3 Strand Fishbone Stitch
- 9: Petals = 3 Strand Satin Stitch
- 10: Flower Center = 3 Strand French Knot

# Embroidery Stitch Instructions

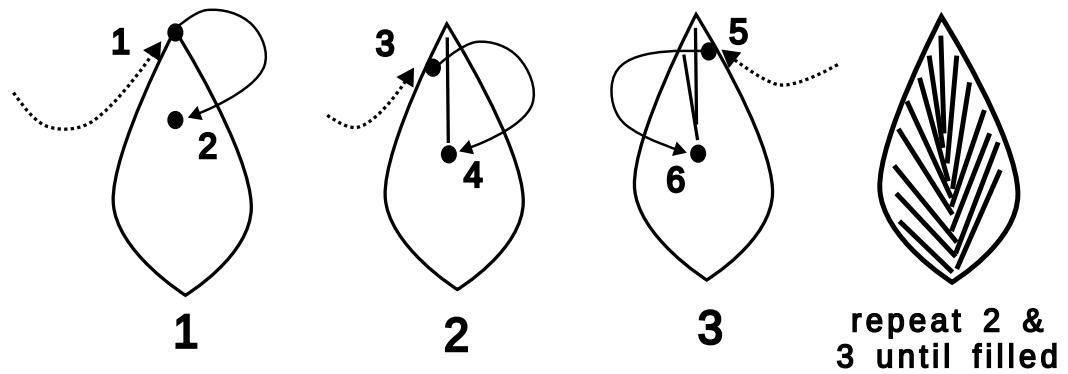
## Backstitch



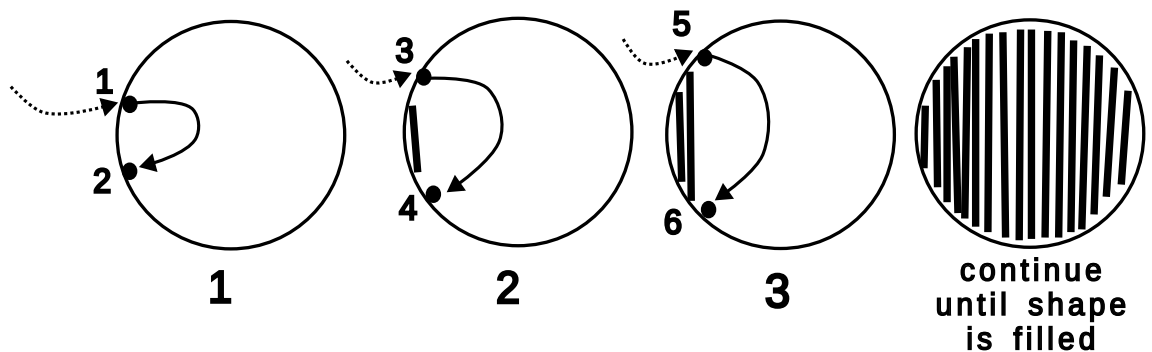
## Stem Stitch



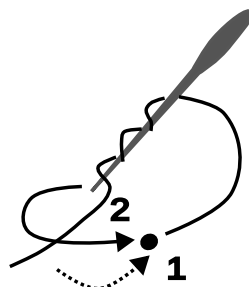
## Fishbone Stitch

## French Knot



1. Bring needle to front of work from behind and wrap thread around needle 2 or 3 times.
2. Pass needle to the back of the work at the same point, keeping light tension on the thread

# Finishing Your Hoop

**When you've finished embroidering your design:**

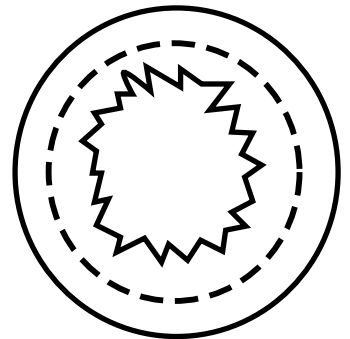
1. Remove fabric from the embroidery hoop
2. Soak your fabric in cold water to remove ink
3. Gently squeeze out excess water (do not twist or wring fabric) and let your fabric air dry flat
4. Optional: Gently iron your fabric
5. Return your embroidered fabric to the hoop and tension
6. Choose your back finishing steps below

## Back Finishing Option 1

Trim away excess fabric on the back of the hoop, as close to the frame as possible

## Back Finishing Option 2

1. Trim away excess fabric on the back of the hoop leaving about 1.5 inches of fabric around the edge
2. Using a running stitch, stitch around the edge of the fabric, 0.5 inch away from the edge
3. Gently pull the thread taught to pull the fabric towards the center of the hoop
4. Glue felt circle to the back of the hoop and let dry



## Back Finishing Option 3

1. Trim away excess fabric on the back of the hoop leaving about 1.5 inches of fabric around the edge
2. Using a running stitch, stitch around the edge of the fabric, 0.5 inch away from the edge
3. Gently pull the thread taught to pull the fabric towards the center of the hoop
4. Stitch felt circle to the back of the hoop using a whip stitch
