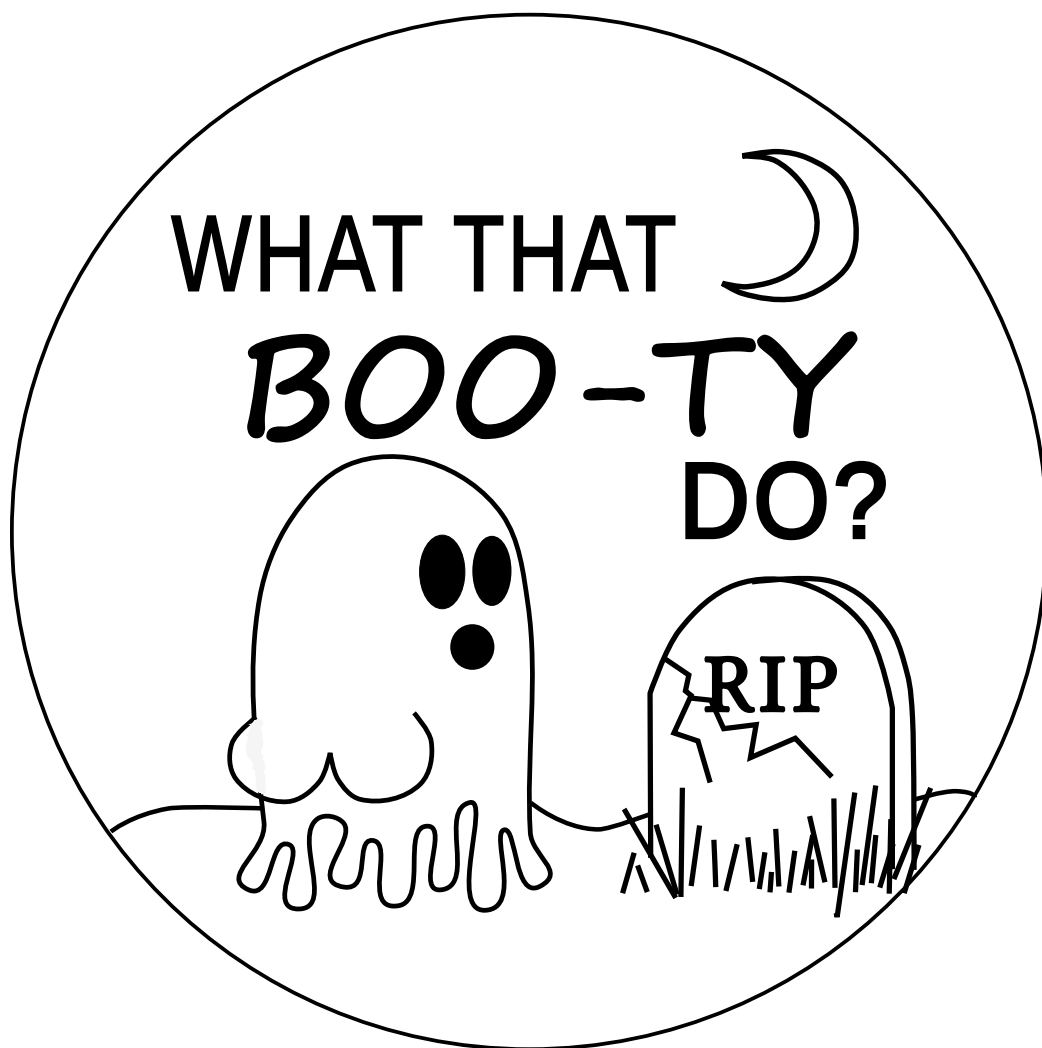


The Cozy Cuttlefish

Pattern

Color Guide



Stitch Guide

1. "WHAT THAT BOO-TY DO?" = 3 strand back stitch
1. "RIP" = 3 strand back stitch
1. Ghost face = 3 strand satin stitch
2. "BOO" = 3 strand whipped back stitch
3. Ghost body = 3 strand stem stitch
4. Tombstone = 3 strand stem stitch
5. Ground = 3 strand stem stitch
5. Grass = 3 strand straight stitch
6. Grass = 3 strand straight stitch
7. Moon = Fill with 3 strand split stitch

Finishing Your Hoop

When you've finished embroidering your design:

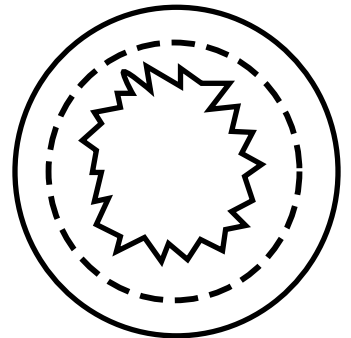
1. Remove fabric from the embroidery hoop
2. Soak your fabric in cold water to remove ink
3. Gently squeeze out excess water (do not twist or wring fabric) and let your fabric air dry flat
4. Return your embroidered fabric to the hoop and tension
5. Choose your back finishing steps below

Back Finishing Option 1

Trim away excess fabric on the back of the hoop, as close to the frame as possible

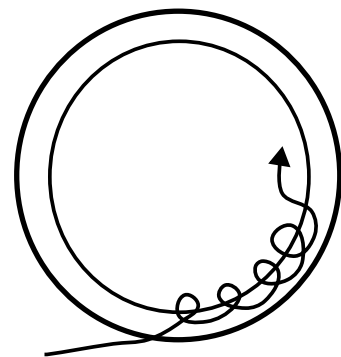
Back Finishing Option 2

1. Trim away excess fabric on the back of the hoop leaving about 1.5 inches of fabric around the edge
2. Using a running stitch, stitch around the edge of the fabric, 0.5 inch away from the edge
3. Gently pull the thread taught to pull the fabric towards the center of the hoop
4. Glue felt circle to the back of the hoop and let dry



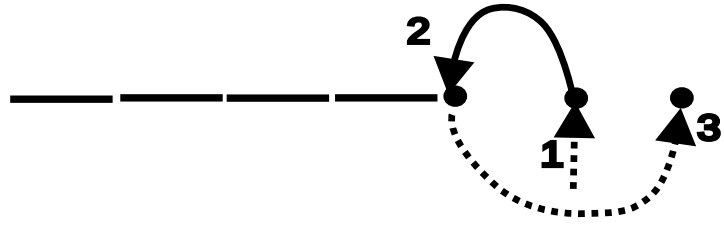
Back Finishing Option 3

1. Trim away excess fabric on the back of the hoop leaving about 1.5 inches of fabric around the edge
2. Using a running stitch, stitch around the edge of the fabric, 0.5 inch away from the edge
3. Gently pull the thread taught to pull the fabric towards the center of the hoop
4. Stitch felt circle to the back of the hoop using a whip stitch

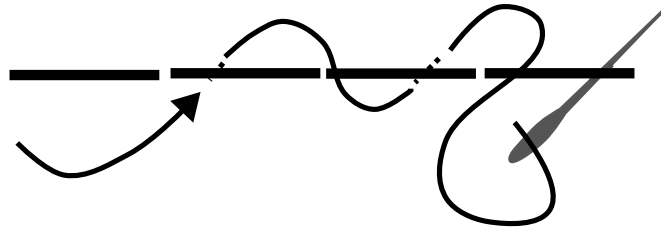

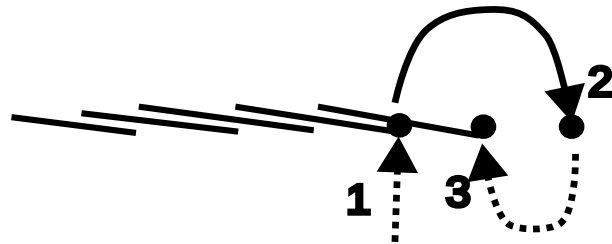
Backstitch



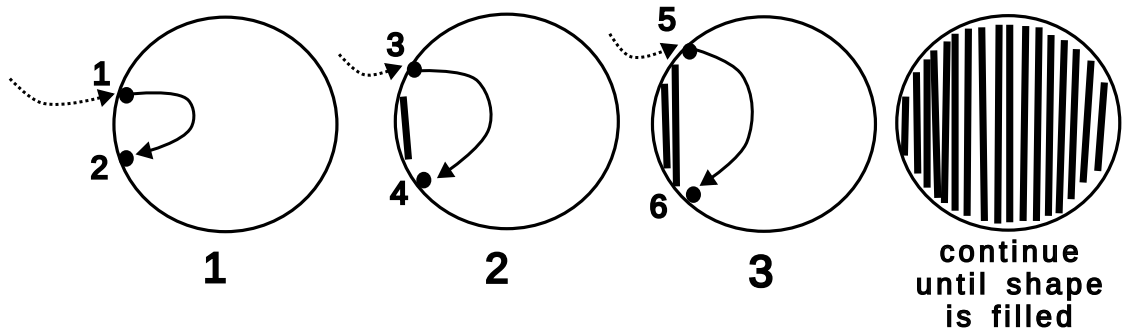
Whipped backstitch



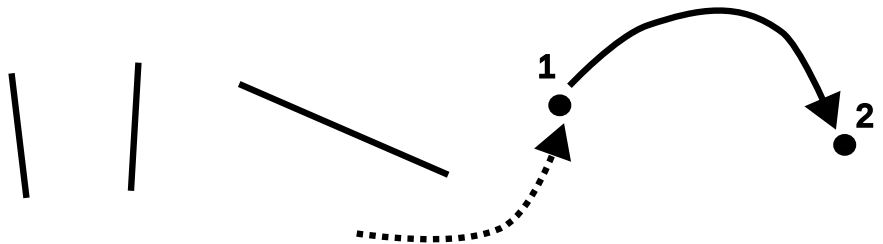
Stem Stitch



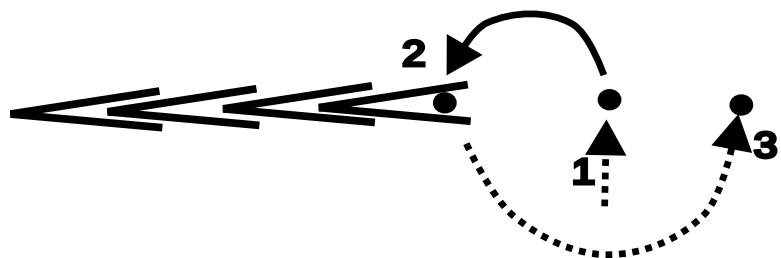
Satin Stitch



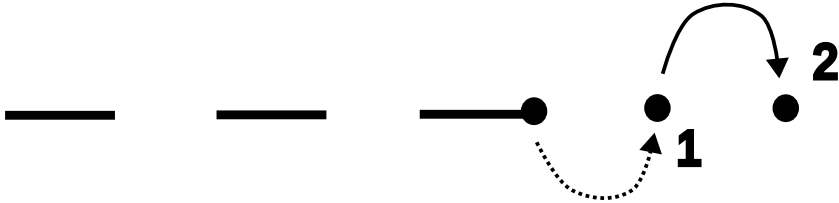
Straight Stitch
